How Do We Help Build Strong Families?

The Centers for Healthy Families are early intervention and prevention programs for parents and caregivers of children prenatal to age five.

Services offered include:

- Young Families Incentive Program
- Pregnancy and Adoption Counseling
- Early Childhood Specialized Therapies
- Family Life Education & Support

Who Can Participate?

- Families from the Fremont area & surrounding communities with children ages prenatal up to age five
- Families also may use the services of the Behavioral Health programs conveniently located on the Garden Level of the Center.



Young Families Incentive Program

Through education and support, this incentive-based program engages parents and children in healthy activities. By participating in these activities, parents earn points to “purchase” new and gently used infant and toddler items (such as clothes, toys, cribs, car seats and diapers) at [no cost](#) in “Sara’s Boutique”.

Healthy behaviors earning points include:

- Well-baby check-ups
- Immunizations
- Early childhood / parenting therapies
- Continuing education
- Home visits
- Breastfeeding
- Parenting classes

Pregnancy and Adoption Counseling

An unexpected pregnancy can be very stressful. Confidential counseling is available at [no cost](#) and for up to six months following delivery. Early Childhood and Parenting Specialized Therapies

The earliest years of life are critical to physical, mental, and emotional health in children. Our focus is to provide healthy development of all children so they may reach their full potential.

Child-Parent Psychotherapy (CPP)

CPP is for children ages 0-6 who have experienced interpersonal violence or trauma.

Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT)

During PCIT, parents learn play therapy skills to enhance their parent-child relationship. Parents also learn to manage their child’s behaviors through behavioral principles and discipline techniques.

Family Life Education and Support

Family stressors can impact our ability to parent in a positive way. We build and strengthen families through Family Life Education & Support.

Nurturing Parenting Program®

The Nurturing Parenting Program® classes emphasize the importance of raising children in a warm, trusting and caring household. Free childcare and a meal are available during each class.
